Tower Light Outages

The number to call to report Tower Light Outages 877-487-6867. Be sure to have your tower registration number handy, and the FCC requires you to log outages, and needs to include time and date of the observed outage, when it was reported and the initials of both the person reporting the outage and the person taking the report.

SBE HAMnet

The "HF" HAMnet takes place on the second Sunday of every month at 0000 GMT. Hal Hostetler, CPBE, WA7BGX, serves as Net Control. The published frequency is 14.205 MHz. Occasionally, that frequency is busy and you may need to move up (no more than 10 kHz) to find the SBE meeting. Hal is Senior Engineer/IT Director at KVOA-TV in Tucson.
