## TOWER LIGHT OUTAGES

The number to call to report Tower Light Outages is 877-487-6867.

Be sure to have your tower registration number handy, and the FCC requires you to log outages, and needs to include time and date of the observed outage, when it was reported and the initials of both the person reporting the outage and the person taking the report.

REMEMBER the FCC is now handing out fines for side light outages NOT noted on station logs !
